It's Your Time: Not Your Fault | August 27 & 28, 2022

Monday Esther 1

Reflect: What is the Shadow Mission of King Xerxes? The experts in the law? What is your shadow mission and how has it impacted your life?

Tuesday Esther 2: 1-18

Wednesday Esther 2:19-23

Reflect: Who is the spiritual friend who serves as your Mortdecai? Why did you choose him or her? Send them a note or prayer text right now thanking them for their presence in your life. If you do not have a Mordecai in your life, ask God to provide.

Prayer: God of eternal wisdom, grant me the strength and courage to seek your will and calling today and every day.

Thursday Esther 3:1-15

Reflect: What is the situation for the Hebrew people? What are the situations/needs/issues in the world and our present day culture that most touch your heart?

Prayer: God of eternal wisdom, grant me the strength and courage to seek your will and calling today and every day.

Friday Esther 4:1-11

Reflect: How does Queen Esther first respond to Mordecai's request? What was her Shadow Mission? What is God saying to you in this passage?

Prayer: God of eternal wisdom, grant me the strength and courage to seek your will and calling today and every day.

Saturday Esther 4:12-5:1

Reflect: How does this passage help you understand the difference between a career and a calling? "It's not your fault but it's your time." What situation in the world makes that observation true for you?

Prayer: God of eternal wisdom, grant me the strength and courage to seek your will and calling today and every day.

Sunday Esther 4:1-5:1

Reflect: What is the position God has called you to or what is your sphere of influence? What are your spiritual gifts, temperament, education, experiences, network of connections, wounds, possessions, time? Like Esther, what is God's purpose for you regarding these things? Prayer: God of eternal wisdom, grant me the strength and courage to seek your will and calling today and every day.
