Flip the Script: Best News Ever | September 17 & 18, 2022

Monday Matthew 4:23-5:2

Prayer: Use me to make your kingdom real and available to all I interact with today.

Friday Luke 8:1-10

Reflect: What was the primary activity Jesus engaged in with his disciples? How would you describe the Kingdom of God?

Prayer: Use me to make your Kingdom known today.

Saturday Matthew 6:9-13, 33

Reflect: What other insights do you get about the Kingdom of God and our appropriate

response from these passages?

*Prayer:* Read the Lord's Prayer as your prayer, verses 9-13.

Sunday Acts 1:1-11

Reflect: What is your ultimate hope? When you leave this earth, ideally, what will be your legacy?

*Prayer:* Use me God to connect one more into a life transforming relationship with your Son Jesus.
