Wednesday Isaiah 26:19 | Ezekiel 37:1-6

Reflect: What do these passages say will happen to us when we die? In what part or parts of your life do you need God to blow in some fresh breath?

Prayer: Breathe on me breath of God and fill me with life anew.

Thursday Mark 12:18-27

Reflect: How did Jesus handle the incorrect teaching about eternal life? What questions do you still have about the afterlife?

Prayer: Heavenly Father, I believe, help my unbelief.

Friday 1 Corinthians 15: 12-22; 58

Reflect: What did Jesus teach us about death? As a result of Jesus' example, how does Paul say we should live here and now? In what ways does your belief about eternity affect your daily life?
