Monday

I Timothy 6:17

Tuesday

I Timothy 6:18

Reflect: Record each of these commands in your journal. Why are each important for our spiritual health and growth?

Prayer: Generous God, forgive my selfish, self-centered ways.

Wednesday

I Timothy 6:17-19

Reflect: What do you sense God saying to you in this passage? What is your takeaway action step for the remainder of the week?

Prayer: Generous God, help me to be rich in a way that honors you and blesses others.

Thursday

Proverbs 18:11

Reflect: What insight into money does this verse teach? What is your application?

Prayer: Generous God, help me to put my hope and find my security in you.

Friday

Ecclesiastes 5:10

Reflect: How much money do you need to "feel rich?" Explain.

Prayer: Generous God, help me to be rich in you.

Saturday

I Timothy 6:6-10

Reflect: On a scale of 1 to 10, one being low, how content are you with your lifestyle? With your financial life? With your life as a whole?

Prayer: Generous God, you have been oh so good to me. Help me bring the first fruits of all you have provided this week into your house.

Sunday

Matthew 6:24

Reflect: What one thing will you do, or not do, this week that demonstrates trust in God instead of money?

Prayer: Generous God, I trust you. Help my lack of trust.
